17 - Pioneer Aviator French Pilot Pierre Verrier Signed 4 X 4 Inch Card At Hendon In 1913. Pierre Verrier, a true pioneer in aviation history. With his unwavering passion and determination, Verrier has left an indelible mark on the world of flight, with his groundbreaking aircraft designs. Verrier's contributions to aviation cannot be overstated. His innovative ideas and relentless pursuit of excellence have revolutionized the way we perceive flight. Flew in Great War wounded on September 30, 1914: a ball in the foot (left). It was during the battle of La Somme. His plane : Henry-Farman. Good condition Est. £80 - 90

18 - Pioneer Aviator Pilot Harold Barnwell signed 3 x 3 piece. BORN 1879, English aviation pioneer, who began as an aircraft builder. He died while test-flying an early Vickers fighter aircraft. Frank and Harold Barnwell built their first glider in 1905 in Balforn and later built three powered aircraft. They then opened the Grampian Engineering and Motor Company in 1906 at Causewayhead in Stirling. From their garage, they produced three aircraft between 1908 and 1910. The first was underpowered and failed to fly, but the second, a canard biplane was successfully flown from a field in Causewayhead under the Wallace Monument on 28 July 1909. Piloted by Harold, it only flew 80 yards (75 m) at an altitude of about four metres before it crashed, but it is still recognised as Scotland's first powered flight. Next, the brothers built a monoplane with which Harold won a prize of £50 offered by the Scottish Aeronautical Society for the first flight of more than a mile to be made in Scotland in January 1911. In 1911 both brothers moved to England, and in 1912 Harold, after gaining his pilot's licence (No.278) at the Bristol school at Brooklands in September joined the staff of the new Vickers School of Flying, also at Brooklands. Here he was the instructor who helped Noel Pemberton Billing win his £50 bet with Frederick Handley Page by learning to fly and gaining a pilot's licence in a single day. In late 1914, Harold Barnwell, now chief test pilot with Vickers Limited, designed a single seat scout or fast reconnaissance aircraft, and had it built without the knowledge or approval of his employers, borrowing a Gnome Monosoupape rotary engine from Vickers' stores to power the aircraft. Barnwell attempted the first flight of his design, named the Barnwell Bullet in early 1915, but the aircraft crashed and was wrecked, possibly due to a miscalculated centre of gravity. Harold Barnwell died on 25 August 1917 while test flying the prototype Vickers Vampire night fighter at Joyce Green, Kent. Webster states that he may have been taken ill while at the controls. 19 - Pioneer French Aviator Pilot Hubert Latham small 3 x 1 inch signature piece. Arthur Charles Hubert Latham (10 January 1883 - 25 June 1912) French aviation pioneer. **He was the first person to attempt to cross the English Channel in an aeroplane.** Due to engine failure during his first of two attempts to cross the Channel, he became the first person to land an aeroplane on a body of water. In August 1909 at the Grande Semaine d'Aviation de la Champagne he set the world altitude record of 155 metres (509 ft) in his Antoinette IV. In April 1910 he set the official World Airspeed Record of 48.186 miles per hour (77.548 km/h) in his Antoinette VII. On 7 January 1910, in Mourmelon-le-Grand, France, Latham climbed to an altitude of 1,100 m (3,600 ft), more than 610 m (2,000 ft) higher than his previous world record and beyond previous claims of unofficial records. Later the same year, in July during the second Semaine de l'Aviation de la Champagne at Reims, Latham again set a world altitude record of 1,384 m (4,541 ft). On 23 April 1910 at Nice, France he set the official World Airspeed Record of 48.186 mph (77.548 km/h) in his Antoinette VII Killed 1912 Game Hunting In Africa. Good condition Est. £140 - 150

20 - Pioneer French Aviator Pilot Philippe Marty signed 4 x4 irregular shaped signature piece, 1910 flew Morane-Saulnier monoplane at Hendon. Boulogne-Sur-Mer, France in 1912. The airshow held on that sunny day was a spectacle like no other, with the magnificent Casino standing tall in the background. Amidst the excitement and anticipation, our eyes are drawn to the awe-inspiring Caudron G2 biplane soaring through the sky. Philippe Marty, a daring aviator and pioneer of early aviation, fearlessly manoeuvres his aircraft with precision and skill. 21 - Pioneer French Aviator Pilot Pierre Chanteloup signed piece approx 3 x 2 inches BORN 1890 DIED 1976. 1913 Flew Caudron Gnome powered version making the first biplane loops and other aerobatic manoeuvres at Issy-les-Moulineaux. The Type F was followed by the Type G-1, which was a preserie with a new nacelle for observation and two were built and evaluated by the Army. Chanteloup epitomizes the audacity and skill required to conquer the skies during a time when flight was still considered a marvel of human achievement. Good condition Est. £80 - 90

22 - Great War ace aviation pioneer Pilot Dudley Travers handwritten letter 1936 from Cairo regarding his travels. Captain Frederick Dudley Travers DFC was an English World War I flying ace credited with nine aerial victories. His later life saw his continued service to his nation in both the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve and in civil aviation. He pioneered air routes into Africa, the Middle East, and India. Travers was almost an ace twice over in the first world war and has the impressive claim to fame of being the only ace flying the Bristol M1C monoplane, it was this fact which drew my attention to his story, as the Bristol was something of an underdog during the conflict, but all may not have been as it seemed. Born in York on the 15th of February 1897, Travers became interested, like so many do, in aviation during his school days peering through the fence at Hedon at the early aircraft of the time. Travers started his personal journey towards the air when he joined the Hertfordshire Yeomanry, part of the territorial force. On the first of January 1916, he graduated from the officer training corps with the rank of Second Lieutenant. He was promoted to Lieutenant in 1917, and on the 17th of April he

transferred to the Royal Flying Corps. Flight training was carried out in Egypt and Travers went solo in just two and half hours! It is highly likely that Travers' training would have been carried out at the RFC training station of Aboukir, which was established in November 1916, this base was responsible not only for training British pilots, but also local cadets, gunners and observers. Photographs from Aboukir and the surrounding bases from the period show BE2 and Avro 504 aircraft as being commonplace so it is likely Travers would have trained on these. His first posting would be to 17 Squadron in Macedonia, part of No. 6 wing, which incorporated 17,47 and 150 Squadrons. Here he initially flew the BE12, a single seat fighter version of the earlier BE2 observation aircraft, fitted with the same engine as the RE8. Travers' first victory came on the 19th of December 1917, flying a BE12, he forced an Albatros D.III out of control until it crashed. By May 1918 Travers had moved over to 150 squadron and the much improved RAF SE5a and, after months had passed since the first, he notched up two further kills that month, on the 15th and 18th respectively, the aircraft downed were an Albatros D.V and a DFW Reconnaissance aircraft. Both of these May Victories were shared. The D.V, shared with Gerald Gordon Bell and the DFW, with Ascheson Goulding. Ending the war with an impressive tally of 9 kills, Travers was given the temporary rank of flying officer on the 5th of December 1919, before moving onto an RAF reserve rank in 1922. 23 - Pioneer Aviator Pilot William Birchenough signed card inscribed HENDON 1914. William Taylor Birchenough (1891-1962) was a pioneering British aviator and test pilot. After leaving Eton Birchenough developed an interest in flying and joined the Grahame-White training school on 7 February 1913. Over the following months he carried out his training under the instruction of Marcus Dyce Manton before being awarded his aviator's certificate on 13 June 1913 in a Grahame White Biplane. Subsequently, he worked for the Grahame-White Company. Birchenough started to regularly compete in flying races at Hendon, from August 1913 onwards often flying a G-W 50 Gnome aircraft or Box-Kites. In January 1914 Birchenough took part in the Upside Down Dinner held at the Royal Automobile Club. Attended by many aviation pioneers, the dinner was held in recognition of those who were first to loop the loop in an aeroplane. In 1914 he competed in a series of air races and won the Shell Motor Spirit Trophy for a special speed contest. On 6 June he flew a Maurice Farman aeroplane at the last Aerial Derby before the outbreak of war and two weeks later he competed in the London to Manchester handicap. On 3 August 1914 Birchenough flew a Maurice Farman aeroplane from Hendon to Leighton Buzzard to carry out a demonstration at a Flower Show but was forced to return after learning that the Government had imposed a ban on flights that day of more than three miles from an aerodrome due to fears of impending war. The following day war was declared in Germany. After the outbreak of World War One he joined the Aircraft Manufacturing Company (Airco) as a test pilot responsible for delivering planes to the Aeronautical Inspection Department (AID) at Farnborough and putting them through their tests. In August 1916 The Aeroplane reported that Birchenough was one of the steadiest and most skilful pilots in the country and that since the outbreak of war he had passed a legion of machines through their tests In 1917 he was elected a member of the Aeronautical Society of Great Britain. 24 - American Pioneer Aviator Pilot Walter L Brock signed card inscribed HENDON 1914. 6 June 1914 The third annual Aerial Derby - postponed from 23 May due to poor weather - is held, sponsored by the Daily Mail. Eleven participants fly over a 94-mile (151-kilometer) circuit beginning and ending at Hendon Aerodrome in London with control points at Kempton Park, Esher, Purley, and Purfleet. Walter Brock is the overall winner for the second consecutive year, completing the course in 1 hour 18 minutes 54 seconds in a Morane-Saulnier G with a handicap of 20 minutes 24 seconds. 11/7/1914 London-Paris return air race won by the American Walter L. Brock. Walter Brock was an American who learned to fly in England in 1912. He quickly moved on to becoming a flight instructor and became the first pilot to deliberately take off in winds of gale strength. Brock achieved fame as a racing pilot, scoring victories all over Europe until the beginning of World War I. The most famous and prestigious race he won was on July 11, 1914, from London to Paris. The aircraft he flew was a Morane-Saulnier H-type Monoplane, powered by an 80 hp Gnome Rotary engine. However, his European racing days came to an abrupt end when war broke out and all British civilian aircraft were ordered to be turned over to the military. In 1916, using parts he brought back with him from Europe, Brock built this aircraft using a smaller 50 hp Gnome engine. Good condition Est. £80 - 90

25 - Pioneer Aviator Pilot Marcus Dyce Manton Signed Piece From Letter Approx 6 X 2 Inches Instructor At Hendon Born 1893. On Thursday 14th May 1914, in glorious weather, the residents of Hethersett were treated to a thrilling air display by two of Britain's most celebrated aviation pioneers, Bentfield Charles Hucks and Marcus Dyce Manton. Benny Hucks, as he was better known, flew his 80 HP Bleriot monoplane in a series of spectacular manoeuvres in the skies above the race goes at Hethersett racecourse. He performed his usual steeple-chasing and vertical banks, and afterwards he gave four passenger flights. After tea he carried out many of his trademark loop the loops and flew upside down. Hucks was joined in the show by his young protégé, 19 year old Marcus Manton who was known as The Wonderful Boy Aviator. At 7 p.m. the new looping machine was brought out, and Manton was strapped in. He rose to 3000ft. before doing an amazing S dive followed by a loop. He landed after completing several more loops. The pair performed the same programme on Friday and Saturday giving a combined demonstration of trick flying which was met with huge enthusiasm from the crowd. They also had a cross-country race to Trowse Viaduct which Manton won by a few yards. During the First World War Marcus Manton continued working as a test pilot and flying instructor. On 11 December 1915 he married Mrs. Ruby Marguerite Paramor née Goodwin. After the war Manton worked with a number of commercial companies including English Electric Company. He subsequently became their chief inspector at Lytham. During the Second World War he was a service liaison officer with Armstrong Whitworth Aircraft Company. Good condition Est. £80 - 90

27 - Great War pioneer Aviator WWI Pilot Percival Phillips DFC Royal Flying Corps signed postcard inscribed on back 11/8/1934 staldon Aerodrome Teignmouth. Director and Pilot of Cornwall Aviation Co. Ltd. b. Trewoon, St. Austell, Cornwall, 28 July 1893. Served in Iraq 1917, killed 1938. Served in the Royal Flying Corps and the RAF. There is a five minute documentary about him on Youtube. Capt. Percival Phillips, D.F.C., R.A.F.O., managing director and chief pilot of Air Publicity, Ltd. It appears that Capt. Phillips, on his way home to Heston from banner-towing work at Hull, put his 504 Avro down in a field at Gamlingay, between Bedford and Cambridge, in order to call upon friends for lunch. In taking-off afterwards in gusty weather the machine struck a treetop, hit the ground, and caught fire. Capt. Phillips, who had been with Air Publicity since their inception in 1935, was formerly managing director of C. W. A. Scott's Flying Display and had safely carried many thousand passengers as a joy-ride pilot. During the war he had seen flying service in Iraq and elsewhere. Last summer, flying a veteran Lynx Avro used daily for banner towing, he won the Devon Air Race. Good condition Est. £60 - 80

28 - Cricket Sir Don Bradman multiple signed RAF Bomber cover, initially signed by WW2 pilot Bill Edrich England legend. Also signed by Geoff Boycott, Graham Gooch, Chris Cowdrey, Alf Glover, David Shepherd. Rare variety highly collectable. Good condition Est. £40 - 50

29 - Apollo 15 astronauts Al Worden and moonwalker Dave Scott signed 30th ann Apollo 15 cover, nice illustration of crew, mission badge and on the moon. Descriptive details on the mission on the back. Numbered 138 of 250 issued. Good condition Est. £40 - 50

30 - WW2 Barnes Wallis and Arthur Harris signed 90th ann Barnes Wallis rare cover. Harris was Great War fighter ace and led Bomber Command in WW2, Wallis invented the Dambusters Bouncing bomb. Good condition Est. £180 - 220

31 - WW2 Six KIA Battle of Britain pilots plus many ace signed US \$1 note. A unique item signed by WW2 US Ambassador John G Winant plus 32 other WW2 autographs includes BOB aces Frances Beamish KIA 1942, Crelin Bodie KIA 1942, Gordon Raphael KIA 1945, William Carnaby KIA 1943, Kenneth Matthews KIA 1943, Dudley Hobbs KIA 1943. Plus, Great War Billy Bishop VC, R Stanford Tuck, Douglas Bader, Peter Simpson, Percival Turner, Peter Townsend, T G Pike, Roy Dutton, Kenneth Holden, Norman Wheeler, Gordon McGregor, Basil Bush, Woody Woodhall. There is a smudged Arthur Tedder autograph as well. There are others not identified, so might yield more valuable autographs with some research. Winant was friends with Churchill and indeed dated his daughter, he committed suicide in 1947. The contrast on the autographs is not great on some as the note background colour does not help. Still a quite rare and very collectable piece of WW2 memorabilia. Good condition Est. £400 - 600

33 - WW2 El Alamein, Arnhem, D-Day FM Montgomery of Alamein signed 1970 25th ann VE Day National Army Museum cover. Good condition Est. £140 - 160

34 - Sherlock Holmes, Star Wars, Lord of the Rings, Dracula Christopher Lee signed 1993 Benham official Sherlock Holmes FDC BLCS88. Rare cover. Good condition Est. £50 - 60

35 - WW2 D-Day Arlette and Georgette Gondree signed 1984, 40th ann D-Day French FDC. They were the first Children Liberated on D-Day, by Mjr John Howard at Pegasus Bridge. Good condition Est. £40 - 60

36 - Lt Cdr Peter Scott DSC, Admiral Maslin signed 70th ann Scott Arrival at South Pole Navy cover. Sir Peter Markham Scott, CH, CBE, DSC, FRS, FZS was a British ornithologist, conservationist, painter, naval officer, broadcaster and sportsman. The only child of Antarctic explorer Robert Falcon Scott, he took an interest in observing and shooting wildfowl at a young age and later took to their breeding. Good condition Est. £20 - 30
